# LOVE

# LOVE IS....MOBILE

#### Materials:

16 small hearts
1 large heart
Stickers
4 pieces of 2 ft yarn
Markers or crayons
Tape or glue



#### Directions:

- 1. On the white side of large red heart, write LOVE IS....1 CORINTHIANS 13: 4-7. Decorate with stickers or drawings.
- 2. Look up I Corinthians 13:4-8 with your child(ren) and on each small heart, have them write the actions of what love is or is not. Younger children they can cut out pictures or draw what those words mean to them. There are 16 different descriptions in these 4 verses.
- 3. You now have 16 hearts with different descriptions of God's love. To play the game: Have a TREASURE HUNT for God's love. Depending on how long you want the game to last; you can hide 2 or 3 per day and make the game last all week, or hide them all at once and finish the game in one day. Have the kids search for them each morning. Once they find the hearts, add them to the mobile (see step 4 below), look up the verse in the bible. Brainstorm with them ways they can demonstrate God's love in the way described on the heart.
- 4. Line up the hearts on the yarn and tape the yarn to the back of the hearts. You will need 3 pieces of yarn. 2 pieces of yarn will have 5 hearts attached and 1 will have 6. Pull the one end of the yarn through the holes already made in the large heart and make a knot.
- 5. Pull the 4<sup>th</sup> piece of yarn through the top hole of the red heart. Make a loop with the yarn. Hang your mobile somewhere where you will see it often and be reminded what love is.

# **WEEKLY ACTIVITIES**

Challenge your family to look for opportunities to demonstrate as many of the "love is" actions.

Offer to help an elderly neighbour with cutting their lawn or cleaning up their lawn fraid.

Have a picnic in the backyard.

Play Hide and Seek in in the dark with flashlights

Make a list of "minute to win it" challenges and have a fun family game night.
