Instructions

PATIENCE

WEEKLY ACTIVITIES

- ◆ One treat vs two: Place one treat in one bowl and a handful or a bigger and better one in another bowl. Offer the small treat to your child/ren before dinner but let them know that if they can wait till after dinner they can have the bigger and better treat. Discuss with them why they chose the way they did.
- ◆ Waiting for a reply: have your child make a home-made card for a friend, grandparent, relative or neighbour. Have them put it in the envelope, help them address it, stamp it and bring it to the mailbox. Talk about the anticipation of receiving a reply and the patience it takes to wait for it to arrive. (you may want to give a heads up to the recipient so they will make sure to respond in a reasonable time frame; in order to reward your child's patience.
- ◆ Yard Bowling: fill up a few (at least one per child) water balloon with water and a few drops of food coloring (so it fits in your palm) and tie them. Place them side by side in the freezer on a baking tray, so they don't touch each other. Fill 10 water bottles with water and set them up like bowling pins (or for night bowling place a colored glow stick (no water) in each bottle). When the water balloons are completely frozen, cut the tied end with scissors and peel off the balloon. Voila....your bowling ball.
- ♦ Balloon Pop: fill balloons with water. Using the sun and a magnifying glass, have a race to see who has the patience to burn a hole in their balloon.
- ◆ Bake a cake: Using the baking process as a way to teach patience and the rewards if we are patient and follow the instructions with out hurrying.
- ◆ Plant some vegetables or flowers: Another opportunity to teach your child about waiting and seeing the rewards.




When you can wait for something or someone without getting upset, you are growing patience.

The fruit of the Spirit is listed in Galatians 5:22-23. The Holy Spirit produces these qualities in the life of each Christian. You can decode the list here.


